On Sunday, October 7th, the 24th Annual Okanagan Marathon will take place in Kelowna. The 42.2K, 21.1K and 10K routes will start and finish in downtown City Park. Detailed traffic control information will be published in the Kelowna Capital News on Friday, September 28th, 2018.

- Start and Finish is at City Park beginning at 7:40 a.m. on Sunday, October 7th.
- For the safety of our participants, residents located along the route are asked to please consider parking off the roadway, using your driveway or adjacent roadway. This would be greatly appreciated!
- Route is outlined on this notice, and includes various road closures and opening times, with road closures ending no later than 2:00 p.m.
- Many roads will remain open to vehicular traffic, but shared with runners/walkers. Please drive slowly and carefully.
- Police will be at all major traffic intersections, and volunteer marshals at those intersections that are busy.

Road Closures and transit impacts for the 2018 Okanagan Marathon

On Sunday, October 7, various complete and partial closures for the **2018 Okanagan Marathon** will be in effect from 7:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Road Closures - The Marathon road races will affect vehicular traffic in the following areas:

North End (North of Highway 97)

- Abbott Street, from Leon Av to Bernard Av closed to traffic (06:30 a.m. to 09:00 a.m.).
- Bernard Av from Abbott Street to Water Street closed to traffic (06:30 a.m. to 09:00 a.m.).
- Water Street from Bernard Av to Sunset Dr closed to traffic (06:30 a.m. to 09:00 a.m.).
- Water Street between Sunset Dr and Ellis Street is open to local traffic and vehicles exiting the area (06:30 a.m. to 09:00 a.m.).
- Sunset Dr from Water Street to Manhattan Dr open to southbound vehicle traffic (06:30 a.m. to 09:00 a.m.), expect delays, no parking permitted (06:30 a.m. to 09:00 a.m.).
- Ellis Street from Recreation Av to Broadway Av open to northbound vehicle traffic, expect delays, (06:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.)
- Manhattan Dr and Recreation Av between Sunset Dr and Richter Street closed to traffic (06:30 a.m. to 12:15 p.m.).
- Richter Street remains open to vehicle traffic.
- Weddell Pl, Trench Pl, Ethel Street, Bay Av, Jones Street, Broadway Av closed except for local traffic (06:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.).
- Manhattan Drive and Guy Street open to local traffic only in a clockwise pattern; enter and exit at Bay Av only (06:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.)

South End (South of Highway 97)

- Hwy 97/Harvey Av, no access Abbott Street (southbound) from Hwy 97/Harvey Av and motorists should turn south at Pandosy Street.
- Abbott Street, Hwy 97/Harvey Av to Meikle Av residents traffic allowed northbound and asked to turn east at closest available roadway, expect delays.
- Meikle Av, Walnut Street and Watt Road closed to southbound traffic; northbound enter at Watt Road only (07:30 a.m. to 01:30 p.m.).
- Lakeshore Road at Swordy Road, participants will be crossing; expect delays (07:45 a.m. to 01:30 p.m.).
- Swordy Road, local traffic only, expect delays (07:45 a.m. to 02:00 p.m.).
- No northbound traffic allowed on Casorso Road, Swordy Road to KLO Road (07:45 a.m. to 01:45 p.m.) consider alternate route via Gordon Drive.
- KLO Road at Campus Drive East, participants will be crossing; expect delays (07:45 a.m. to 02:00 p.m.).
- Raymer Av from Gosnell Rd to Pandosy Street closed except for local traffic (07:45 a.m. to 02:00 p.m.).
- Richter Street at Raymer Av, participants will be crossing; expect delays (07:45 a.m. to 02:00 p.m.).
- Tutt Street, Raymer Av to West Av, local traffic only, expect delays (07:45 a.m. to 02:00 p.m.).
- West Av, Tutt Street to Abbott Street, local traffic only, expect delays (07:45 a.m. to 02:00 p.m.).
- Pandosy Street at West Av, participants will be crossing; expect delays (07:45 a.m. to 02:00 p.m.).
- Northbound Mission area traffic should consider avoiding Lakeshore Road, north of Cook Road and should use Gordon Drive instead (07:45 a.m. to 02:00 p.m.).

Motorists are to observe all traffic controls advising of the road closures and watch for participants along the route.

Transit services may be affected for #1, #2, #8, #12 and #97. For further information on bus schedules during the event, visit <http://bctransit.com/kelowna>

Residents and visitors are asked to yield to participants running on pathways in City Park and Gyro Park.
